DEAR COLLEAGUES AND FRIENDS,

I want to thank you for your support of the Medical Society Consortium on Climate & Health (Consortium). With your help, we've grown dramatically. We currently have 26 medical societies representing 60% of all U.S. physicians, and 40 public health affiliates representing millions of health professionals. Our affiliates include state clinician climate action groups in Virginia, Ohio, Florida, Wisconsin, North Carolina, Vermont, Minnesota, Montana, Utah, and Georgia. More than 720 individual health professionals are acting as advocates by educating their colleagues, the public, and policymakers about the health crises caused by climate change and the health benefits of climate solutions.

Our 2019 Annual Meeting was a turning point for the Consortium. We made our movement stronger and more coherent by joining forces with other key players in the health system, including nurses, social workers, hospitals and health systems, and academic institutions. We helped to organize these groups to produce and release a consensus policy agenda that identified climate change as a "health emergency" and provided a ten-point roadmap of policy priorities to address climate change and promote the health of all Americans. More than 140 health organizations have endorsed this "U.S. Call to Action on Climate, Health, and Equity: A Policy Action Agenda," which can be seen, and endorsed, at climatehealthaction.org.

In addition to bringing our health and medical community together behind a unified climate and health agenda, the release of the Policy Action Agenda garnered a large amount of media attention—leading to nearly 500 stories in news outlets across the nation.

To keep this momentum going, I'm writing to ask for your sponsorship of our upcoming Annual Meeting in May 2020. This meeting will be another crucial step forward. It will create a major opportunity for us to ensure that the health emergency being created by climate change, and the profound health benefits associated with climate solutions are prominently featured in the final stages of the 2020 election cycle.

The meeting will feature a range of presentations and discussions to expand our understanding of impacts, risks, and solutions—including prevention (e.g., transportation, agriculture, buildings, and energy generation), preparedness, and fairness/equity.

WE ARE GROWING FAST

- We are adding members our 26 societies represent over 60% of all U.S. physicians and our 40 public health affiliates have millions of members. All groups are increasing climate change activities.
- Our website has received over 137,000 page views since 2017.
- News coverage of the Consortium and its activities and press statements continue to be robust, with over 520 news stories in 2019 appearing in varied mainstream and health media outlets.
- Physician activity is growing at the state level in California, Florida, Georgia, Minnesota, Montana, North Carolina, Ohio, Vermont, Virginia, Utah, and Wisconsin.
- Our newsletter reaches over 1,800 subscribers each month. Items are carried forward by member newsletters.
- Social media activity on Twitter and Facebook is vigorous, with over 3000 followers and 80% increased engagement during 2019.

WE ARE MAKING OUR VOICES HEARD

- The Consortium and prominent health organizations released the U.S. Call to Action on Climate, Health, and Equity: A Policy Action Agenda in June. This agenda is endorsed by over 140 societies of medicine and nursing, schools of medicine, nursing, and public health, and over 500 hospitals and health systems.
- Physician advocates expanded their advocacy activities, which now stand at 1083 logged over the last two years. These include: 422 presentations, 338 visits to policymakers, 285 published opeds and letters to the editor, and 38 research papers.
- We filed formal testimony opposing EPA actions to rollback performance standards for coal plants, fuel economy and clean car rules, loosen mercury and air toxic emission standards, and weaken regulations that decrease methane pollution.
- Our monthly newsletter named a Champion of the Month, suggested advocacy actions, offered news updates, and announced continuing education events.
- We exhibited at the annual meetings of medical societies and used social media at the meetings to share physician pledges to act on climate.
